VS Developers, Recognised as a Startup by Government of India, operating under the brand name **venkys.io** (hereinafter referred to as the "Second Party" or "VS Developers"), having its registered office at, 301, Tower-B, Phoenix Primea, Financial District, Nanakramguda, Gachibowli, K.V.Rangareddy- 500075, Telangana.

1. OBJECTIVES OF THE AGREEMENT:

- To establish a collaborative academic framework between the University and VS Developers for imparting online training programs, industry-relevant internships, student projects and faculty development initiatives for the benefit of students and staff of the Department of Electrical Engineering.
- To provide structured online training sessions aligned with the National Education Policy (NEP) and tailored to equip students with emerging technical skills in the domains of Embedded Systems, Artificial Intelligence, Machine Learning, Internet of Things, Secure Hardware Platforms, and Smart Energy Systems.
- To enable real-time project-based internships for students in virtual or hybrid mode, wherein students will engage in practical implementation under the mentorship of industry experts provided by VS Developers.
- To organize periodic Faculty Development Programs (FDPs) designed to upskill the teaching fraternity in relevant tools, technologies, and pedagogical advancements, along with the issuance of joint certification.
- To conduct expert-led workshops, webinars, and guest lectures that facilitate exposure to contemporary industry practices and bridge the gap between academia and industry.
- To optionally provide suggestions for curriculum design, enhancement of elective modules, or specialized training components based on mutual understanding and request.

2. THE OBJECTIVES INCIDENTAL OR ANCILLARY TO THE ATTAINMENT OF THE MAIN OBJECTIVES:

- To define and distribute responsibilities, the University shall act as the facilitator for communication, outreach, and infrastructure, while VS Developers shall act as the content and delivery partner.
- To jointly issue certificates of participation, completion, or internship as applicable under the respective programs.
- To provide feedback mechanisms, assessments, or evaluations for program effectiveness, and maintain academic rigor in delivery.



- To ensure mutual non-disclosure and confidentiality concerning proprietary materials, shared documents, project data, or personal information of participants for a minimum period of two (2) years from the termination of the Agreement.
- To recognize that intellectual property developed jointly shall be co-owned, while individually developed content or frameworks shall remain the property of the originating party unless otherwise agreed in writing.
- To clarify that no financial remuneration shall be expected by either party for student internships and that expenses for any FDPs or specialized services shall be mutually agreed upon prior to commencement.
- To provide that either party may terminate the Agreement with a written notice of two (2) months, subject to the completion of any ongoing commitments.
- To resolve any disputes amicably, and failing that, through arbitration governed by the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996. The jurisdiction for legal matters shall be Hyderabad, Telangana.

3. DURATION

This Agreement shall be valid for a period of two (2) years from the date of execution and may be extended further upon mutual consent of both parties.

4. AMENDMENT CLAUSE

Any modifications, addendums, or amendments to this Agreement shall be made in writing and signed by duly authorized representatives of both parties.
