Agenda of the Meeting:

- > To discuss and approval for implementing the Relative Grading System from the year 2022-2023 onwards for B.E.
- ➤ Introduction of In-House assessment for Laboratory Examinations from the academic year 2022-2023.
- > Any other matter with permission of Chair.

At the outset the Principal, UCE (A), OU welcomed all the members of the committee and gave an overview pertaining to relative grading system and initiated the discussion.

The following resolutions were adopted during the meeting:

- (i). 32nd Academic Council approved to implement Relative Grading System to B.E I Semester for the year 2022-2023 onwards. In view of this, a committee was constituted under the Chairmanship of Prof. V. Bhikshma, Director CDAAC, Prof. P. Chandra Sekhar, Vice-Principal, Prof. Narsimhulu Sanke, Director of Evaluation Exam Cell as Members. In this connection the Committee has visited NIT, Warangal on 23rd February 2023 and BITS Pillani, Hyderabad on 14th March, 2023. The Committee briefed the outcome of the visit. The Committee has informed that **No Choice in Question Paper** to be given in order to implement **Relative Grading system**.
- (ii). It is resolved to modify the Question Paper Pattern for Semester End Examination (SEE) for BE I semester 2022-23 academic year. The question paper consists of a total SIX questions, wherein Q1 will have five (5) bits and the remaining FIVE questions will cover the five units of the concerned syllabus. All the six questions carry 10 marks each, making it a total of 60 marks. The questions may be divided into parts and marks can be allotted accordingly, making it a total of 10 marks for each question (as enclosed question paper pattern).
- (ii). It is also decided to communicate the Question Paper Pattern to BE I Semester Students.
- (iii). Principal informed that the Premier Institutions are conducting Lab External Examinations without involving external examiners from other Institutions. He suggested to adopt the same procedure to conduct Lab External Examination by deputing External Examiners with In-house faculty members.
- (iv). The principal thanked the members for their wholehearted support in implementing the Relative Grading system. He also thanked the three member committee; Prof. V. Bikshma, Prof. P. Chandra Sekhar, Prof. Narsimhulu Sanke, for their efforts and feed back after studying the system in three premier Institutes of the state.

Meeting ended with vote of thanks by Vice Principal.
