- 1. The Almanac for M.E / M.Tech II Semester (Regular / CEEP) all branches is revised in view of the holidays declared by the OU due to incessant rains.
- 2. Postponement of (5) UG Exams due to the incessant rains & change of Almanac is discussed and (5) UG Exams to be re-scheduled after 09th August, 2023.
- 3. The Academic and Administrative Audit (AAA) by the External Members to be conducted after 15th of August, 2023 and Heads of the Departments are advised to fill the form and keep it ready.
- 4. Chairperson, Governing Body has suggested to obtain Annual Performance Appraisal Reports (APARs) from all the Faculty Members and Confidential Reports for Non-Teaching staff as it is very important for NBA/NAAC.
- 5. An amount @ 50% of Institutional Overheads of the sanctioned Projects to be retained and deposited into Research Development Fund (RDF) so as to utilize for research purposes and also to encourage the Faculty for Research activities and to get more number of Projects.
